

To enroll in the program, each applicant must fill out an application and mail it to Canada Customs. Include a check for \$50.00 (US Currency) per person for individuals 18 years of age and over. Appear in person for interview, and various law enforcement checks.

Currently, there is no NEXUS application processing in Ohio or Pennsylvania. However, travelers already in possession of a NEXUS card may use it in lieu of the I-68 or OARS programs for telephonic reporting. These programs will allow the holder to report their arrival from any location on Lake Erie to 1-888-523-BOAT(2628); all others must go to an OARS location or a reporting station.

BENEFITS OF ALTERNATIVE INSPECTIONS PROGRAMS:

While participants of Alternative Inspections Programs are not exempt from the physical reporting requirements, it greatly reduces the likelihood they will have to present themselves for a physical inspection.
